# **Linguistic Learning (Emergent Literacy L1)**

#### **Activity 1: CVC Word Basket**

A CVC (Consonant-Vowel-Consonant) word basket is a fun and engaging way to help young learners develop reading skills. By focusing on simple three-letter words like "cat", "mat" and "tap," these activities reinforce phonemic awareness and decoding abilities.

#### **Material Required:**

- Medium size basket or any waste small container
- 4. Sketch pens
- 5. Fevicol
- 2. Clay/dough/waste paper to fill the basket
- 3. Paper cutout of fruits or vegetables

#### Steps to make CVC word basket: -

#### (Parents may help the child make this basket by following the given steps.)

Step 1: Take a medium size reusable basket and fill it up with clay or paper strips.

**Step 2**: Child will make a cutout of his/her choice like fruits/vegetables/candies etc. He/ She will write CVC words in the center of the cutout (Kindly refer to the image shown.) Use waste material to fill the basket and place the cutouts in a way that all the CVC words are visible. Also, help the child count the number of CVC word cutouts and write it on the basket.

**Step 3:** Students will create a basket full of words that is given to them according to the roll no (refer to the table given below).

\*Kindly refer to the image for an idea. Students can use their own creativity to decorate and choose any cutout of their choice to fill the basket.






गतिविधि 2:
