Sustainability Reminder

Why throw away when you can reuse and play?

Activity- Wind Chimes- Nature's Little Music Makers !

(For Roll Numbers- 1 to 11)

Wind chimes are like nature's way of singing when the wind blows, filling the air with soft, happy tunes. Now, let's make our own!

Grab 5 old toilet rolls or kitchen towel rolls and write a blend sound like "cl", "bl", "fl", "gl" and "sl" on each one. Decorate them with bright colors, stickers and your coolest doodles. Once you have dressed them up, thread string or yarn through each roll, tying knots to keep them in place. Hang your wind chimes in a breezy spot and let the wind do its thing.

Listen closely – you just turned old tubes into a magical wind song!

Activity- Eco Word Tree- Let's Grow Some Words!

Look around you – words are hiding everywhere! From “slide” to “clay” and “trash”, so many blend words are right in your surroundings. Let's turn them into a magical Eco Word Tree that's good for the planet and fun to make!

How to Make an Eco Word Tree:

1. Take an old plastic bottle or bowl to make the base of your tree.
2. Fill it with soil and fix a twig or branch in the center.
3. Cut out leaf shapes from old newspapers or magazines. (12 leaves)
4. Write one blend word on each leaf. (total 12 words)
5. Hang or stick the leaves onto the branches of your tree.

Make your Magic **Eco Word Tree** colourful and eco-friendly by decorating it with material available at home like pistachio shells, bindis, button, laces etc...!

Let your imagination bloom!*

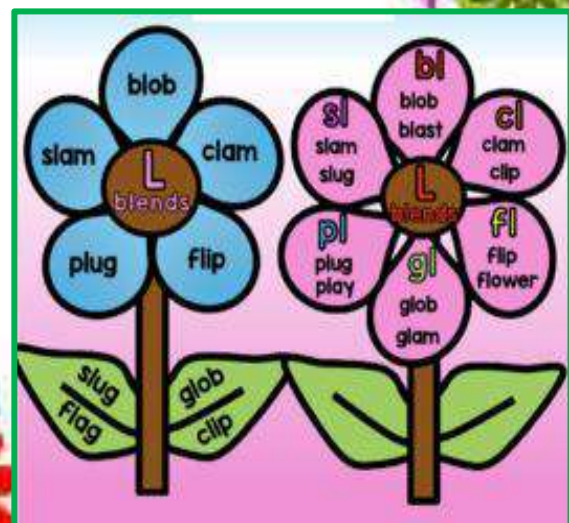
Things you need:

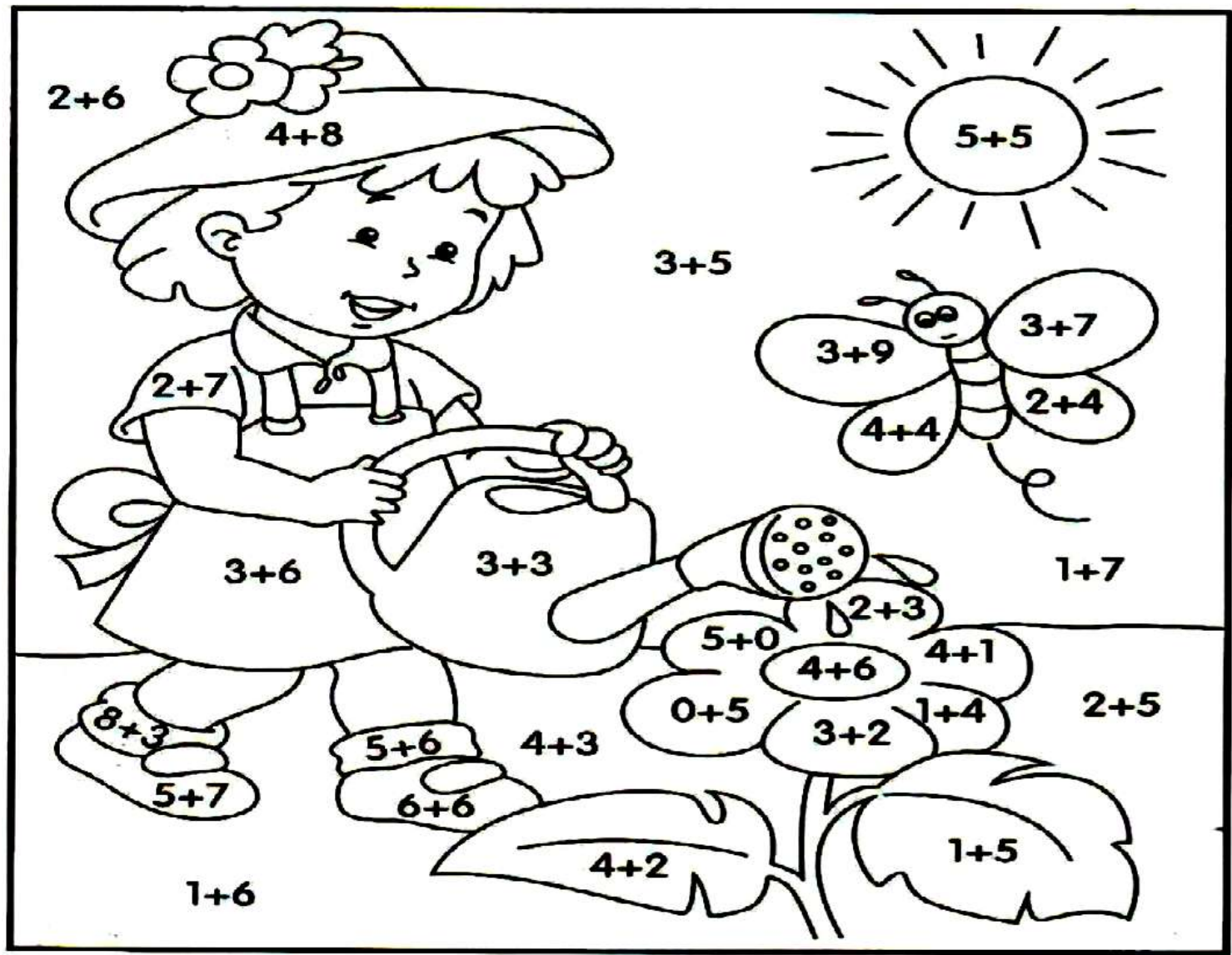
Let's Add, Color & Care for Nature!

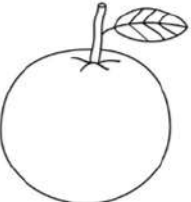

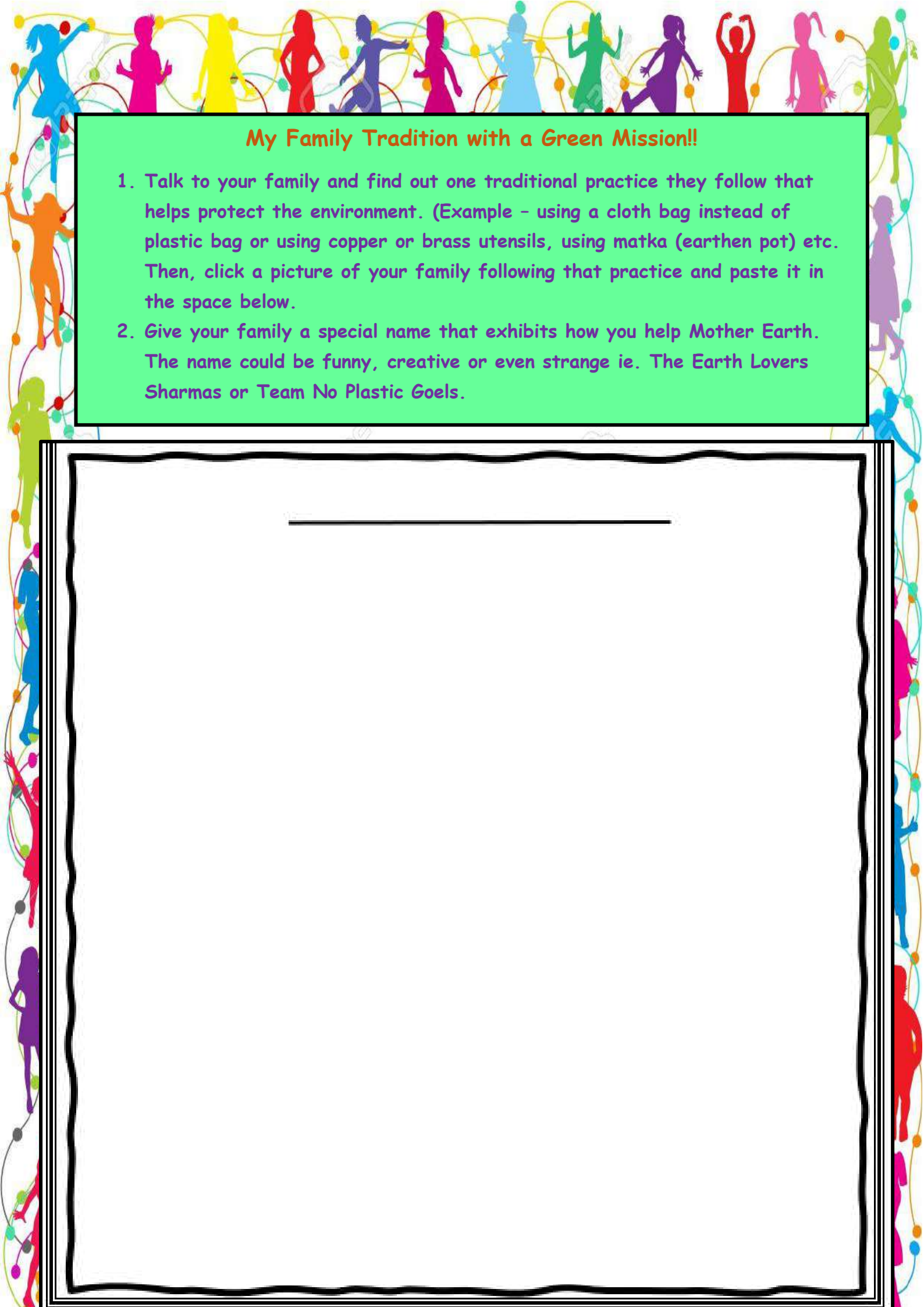
Let's make every small action count!
