

TOPIC: PLANTS

<u>Objective</u>: To help students explore and understand different types of plants, their uses, and how they grow.

As a nature lover show your green thumbed talent and do the following;

- 1. Choose any TWO plants from your surroundings (garden, park, neighbourhood, or even your kitchen garden).
- 2. For each plant, find and write the following details:
- Name of the Plant
- Is it a tree, shrub, herb, or climber?
- Where does it grow? (Sunlight/shade, soil type if known)
- What are its parts used for? (Example: fruits, leaves, flowers, etc.)
- One fun fact about the plant



3. Draw or paste a picture of each plant on an A4 size sheet.

Now explore from the internet or a book and find one interesting plant that does not grow in your local area. Find two dissimilarities between the one that grows in your area and the one that does not.

Some clues:

Fridge: Model number (e.g. LG 4321)

TV remote: Battery expiry date Car/Bike: Number plate Books: ISBN numbers

1. Identify the Greatest & Smallest Numbers from the list

2. Place Value Breakdown:

Choose any 2 numbers and write their expanded form:

Example: 4725 = 4000 + 700 + 20 + 5

- 2. Topic: "Flight Finder!"
 - 1. Find and write down the 4-digit flight numbers of the following flights:
 - Indigo flight from Delhi to Mumbai
 - Air India flight from Lucknow to Delhi
 - SpiceJet flight from Delhi to Bengaluru
 - Vistara flight from Delhi to Kolkata
 - Any flight from your nearest airport
 - 2. On an A4 sheet, do the following:
- a) Make a Place Value Chart (Thousands to Ones) and place each flight number in the chart.
- b) Write the Number Name of each flight number.

(Example: 6234 – Six thousand two hundred thirty-four)

- c) Compare the Numbers:
 - Identify the greatest and smallest flight number.
 - Find the difference between the two.

Both the activities to be done on an A4 size pastel sheets.
